


So go ahead, mix it up and create a beautiful space!

The custom coffee table was made using our client's **grandfather's door** as the centerpiece, showcasing its sentimental value in a **new** and innovative way.



Give it a new purpose.

Invest in the things that bring you joy.

Sometimes you may come across an item that you love so much that you don't care about its cost. You just feel the urge to have it.

However, if you are on a **budget** and you cannot afford that perfect accessory, don't lose hope. Keep searching, and you may find an alternative that is not as grand but will still give you the **same look** at a more affordable price.



Cost: \$3,279

Wrap yourself and your guest in luxury by using bedding in soft colors such as rose, tan, and soft peach. Add hotel sheeting to bring an elegant touch to your bedrooms. White duvet covers look great on top of any color sheets. In my master bedroom, I have seven sets of sheets, four of them are patterned, and three are colored. I love placing patterns such as white sheets with pink polka dots in one guest room and grey on white birds on branches in the other. Think outside of the box!

I suggest using between 4 to 8 soft fiber-fill pillows on the guest beds. This is a trick I learned from staying in hotels and use when I'm styling Air B and B's. These types of pillows allow your guest to stack, smoosh, and fold to their heart's content, making the pillows the exact density they need to sleep comfortably. Add a bench at the end of the beds, so they can sit to get dressed.



Let your entry introduce you to your guest. Tell them who you are and what you like...







Adding accessories such as elegant side tables, lounge chairs, matching table lamps, framed family photos, artwork, and large mirrors will spruce up your entryway, creating a welcoming impression for guests while also meeting practical storage and organizational needs.
